

ORDINANCE NO. 03-20-07

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE 2003 EDITION OF THE INTERNATIONAL URBAN-WILDLAND INTERFACE CODE AS AMENDED BY THE UTAH DIVISION OF FIRE, FORESTRY AND LANDS

This Ordinance of Emery County adopts the 2003 edition of the International Wildland-Urban Interface Code as currently amended by the Division of Forestry, Fire and State lands, regulating and governing the mitigation of hazard to life and property from the intrusion of fire from wildland exposures, fire from adjacent structures and prevention of structure fires from spreading to wildland fuels in Emery County and providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees therefor.

Emery County does ordain as follows:

Emery County Clerk/Auditor, being marked and designated as the International Wildland-Urban Interface Code, 2003 edition, including Appendix, as amended by the Utah Division of Fire, Forestry and Lands, as published by the International Code Council, be and is hereby adopted as the Urban-Wildland Interface Code of Emery County in the State of Utah for regulating and governing the mitigation of hazard to life and property from the intrusion of fire from wildland exposures, fire from adjacent structures and prevention of structure fires from spreading to wildland fuels as herein provided; providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees therefor; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of said Urban-Wildland Interface Code on file in the office of the Emery

County Clerk/Auditor are hereby referred to, adopted, and made a part hereof, as if fully set out in this Ordinance, with the additions, insertions, deletions and changes, if any, prescribed in this Ordinance.

- Section 2. That if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. Emery County hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section, subsection, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses and phrases be declared unconstitutional.
- Section 3. That nothing in this Ordinance or in the Wildland-Urban Interface Code hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court; nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this Ordinance.
- Section 4. That the Emery County Clerk/Auditor is hereby ordered and directed to cause this Ordinance to be published in a newspaper of general circulation and posted as required by law.
- Section 5. That this Ordinance and the rules, regulations, provisions, requirements, orders and matters established and adopted hereby shall take effect and be in full force and effect fourteen (14) days from and after the date of its final passage and adoption.
- Section 6. Specific boundaries of natural or man-made features of wildland-urban interface areas shall also be shown on the wildland area interface map. The legal description of such areas is described as follows:

R6E T13S; R6E T14S; R6E T15S; R6E T16S; R6E T17S; R6E T18S, all located within Emery County, State of Utah.
