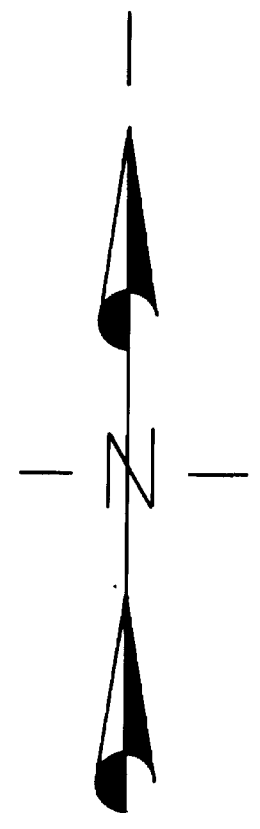
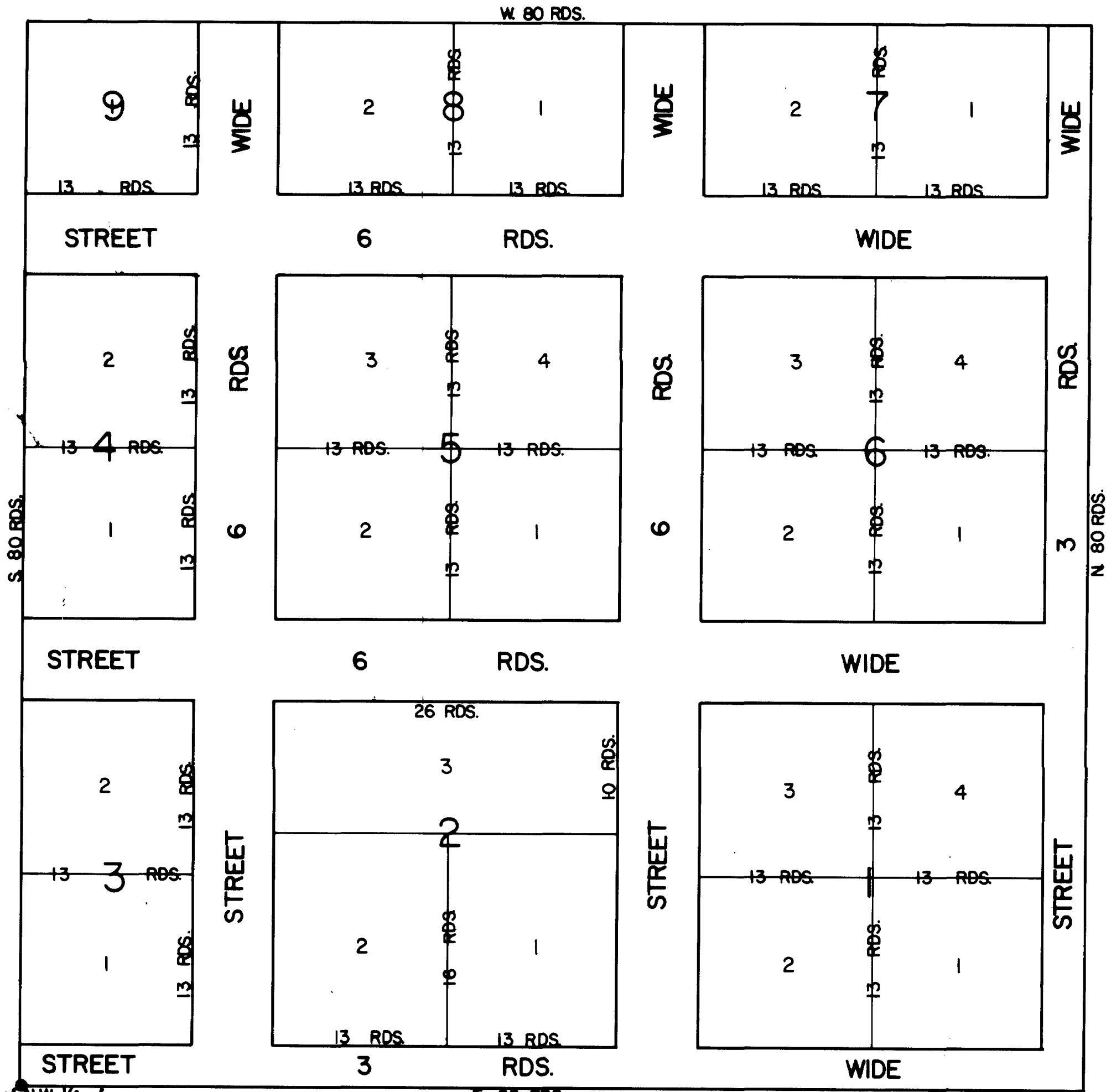


CARROLL'S SUBDIVISION ORANGEVILLE TOWNSITE EMERY CO., UTAH

Know all men by these presents, that we Frank Carroll and Annie Carroll, husband and wife, of Orangeville, Emery Co., Utah, hereby certify and declare that we are sole owners of the lands embraced in this plat, that the lots herein shown are 13 by 13 rods, except lots 1 and 2 in block 2 which is 16 by 13 rods and lot 3 in block 2 which is 26 by 10 rods as shown in this plat, that all streets herein shown has a width as indicated in rods; that all streets herein shown are hereby set apart for and dedicated to the use of the public forever, that this plat is hereby denominated "Carroll's Subdivision Orangeville Townsite."
