

BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION

Begin on a fence at the South West corner of grantors property at a point which is S89° 19'W - 1320 feet ± along the section from the south west corner of Section 5, TI7S, R7E, S.L.B.& M. and running thence North 1788.18 feet along said fence to a point on a 530 feet radius curve to the left, thence Southeasterly along said curve an arc distance of 342.119 feet, thence N87°17′13″E - 562.687 feet to a point of tangency with a 930.00 feet radius curve to the right, thence along said curve for an arc distance of 418.246 feet to a point of tangency with a 940.00 feet radius curve to the left, thence along said curve for an arc distance of 345.130 feet to a point of tangency with a 150.00 feet radius curve to the right, thence along said curve an arc distance of 158.439 feet to a point of tangency with a 380,00 feet radius curve to the left, thence along said curve for an arc distance of 347.969 feet to a point of tangency with a 1280.00 feet radius curve to the right, thence along said curve for an arc distance of 535.724 feet to a point of tangency with a 820.00 feet radius curve to the right, thence along said curve an arc distance of 417.258 feet to a point of tangency with a 180,00 feet radius curve to the left, thence along said curve for an arc distance of 58.596 feet, thence S07°09'06"E-701.509'± feet to the South line of said Section 5, S89-19-W - 2915.00 feet along said South line to the P.O.B.
