



At-Risk Designation Request Form

Utah Code 20A-2-606

What does this request do?

State law allows certain non-government individuals and organizations to obtain some of your voter registration information. This form allows certain individuals to request that their voter registration record is classified as **at-risk**. Personally identifiable information will not be publicly released. The information that must be provided is the residential/ mailing address, party affiliation and age range of the voter.

Utah law only allows certain categories of individuals to withhold their voter registration records from disclosure.

- A public figure (Definition can be found in Utah Code 20A-1-102(62))
- A member of the armed forces
- An individual protected by a protective or protection order

Please provide a statement below that explains why you meet the category you indicated above. This section is **not** required if you are a victim of domestic violence or dating violence, you are likely to be a victim of domestic or dating violence, you reside with an individual who is a victim of domestic or dating violence, or you reside with an individual who is likely to be a victim of domestic violence or dating violence. Attach additional sheets if necessary. Your election official may require you to provide additional documentation to verify that you meet the category that you indicated above.

Read the disclaimer statement below and then sign and date.

Submitting this request limits the disclosure of your voter registration record after this form has been processed by the election official. Submitting this form does not remove or prevent the disclosure of your personal information that may be located in other government or commercial databases. Unless you are or likely to be a victim of domestic violence or dating violence, or an individual who resides with an individual who is or likely to be a victim of domestic violence or dating violence, the election official may request additional documentation to verify that you meet the category that you indicated above.

“At-Risk” Qualifications

OPTION A – At-Risk Per Elections Code 20A-2-606 (outdated ref on form)

Should use LGO form but can use County form

- An individual who is a victim of, or who is threatened with, domestic violence or dating violence
 - A law enforcement officer
 - A public figure (per 20A-1-102(62) – LGO form)
- (62)
- (a) "Public figure" means an individual who, due to the individual being considered for, holding, or having held a position of prominence in a public or private capacity, or due to the individual's celebrity status, has an increased risk to the individual's safety.
 - (b) "Public figure" does not include an individual:
 - (i) elected to public office; or
 - (ii) appointed to fill a vacancy in an elected public office.
- A member of the armed forces (per 20A-1-513 – LGO email 04/02/2026)
- (1) As used in this section:
- (a) (i) "Armed forces" means the United States Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, Space Force, and Coast Guard.
 - (ii) "Armed forces" includes the National Guard.
- An individual protected by a protective or protection order
 - Someone who lives in the same household as someone above

OPTION B – At-Risk Per GRAMA 63G-2-303

MUST use County form

63G-2-303. Private information concerning certain government employees.

(1) As used in this section:

- (a) "At-risk government employee" means a current or former:
 - (i) peace officer as specified in Section [53-13-102](#);
 - (ii) state or federal judge of an appellate, district, justice, or juvenile court, or court commissioner;
 - (iii) judge authorized by Title 39A, Chapter 5, Utah Code of Military Justice;
 - (iv) judge authorized by Armed Forces, Title 10, United States Code;
 - (v) federal prosecutor;
 - (vi) prosecutor appointed pursuant to Armed Forces, Title 10, United States Code;
 - (vii) law enforcement official as defined in Section [53-5a-311](#);
 - (viii) prosecutor authorized by Title 39A, Chapter 5, Utah Code of Military Justice; or
 - (ix) state or local government employee who, because of the unique nature of the employee's regular work assignments or because of one or more recent credible threats directed to or against the employee, would be at immediate and substantial risk of physical harm if the employee's personal information is disclosed.
- (b) "Family member" means the spouse, child, sibling, parent, or grandparent of an at-risk government employee who is living with the employee.
